For which scholarship should I apply?

Collegiate Scholarship:

- Any high school senior who is a Fort Lee Federal Credit Union member and **entering into any area of study at a two- or four-year college/ university.**

Career Path Scholarship:

- Any high school senior who is a Fort Lee Federal Credit Union member and **pursuing a certificate or technical degree at a career college, community college or technical school.**

Am I eligible to apply?

- The applicant must be a high school senior.
- The applicant must have a share (savings) account with his or her name as the primary member at Fort Lee Federal Credit Union.
- **New Members please note:** While there is no minimum length of membership required, membership documents must be processed prior to scholarship deadline.

How do I apply?

- Neatly print or type the application. All attachments must be typed.
- All information given on the application must be true.
- The application must be signed.
- Decisions made by the Fort Lee Federal Credit Union Scholarship Committee are final.
- Applications may be mailed or hand-delivered to a branch.

- **All completed forms, transcripts and references must be received by Fort Lee Federal Credit Union by end of business day on Friday, March 8, 2019.**
- **Late submissions will not be considered. Post-marked dates will not be considered.**

How are winners chosen?

- Applications are reviewed anonymously by a neutral selection committee.
- Selection criteria may include, but are not limited to: GPA, extra-curricular and/or community involvement, career goals and written skills.

How will I know if I've won a scholarship?

- Only scholarship winners will be notified in early April and presented an award at the Fort Lee FCU Annual Meeting at the end of April.

How will I receive scholarship funds?

- In order to receive scholarship proceeds, the applicant must be a full-time student and submit a class schedule for his or her first semester in college/trade school.
